31 RedPeak employees “get their hands dirty” for Family Homestead

The cleanup day for the Denver-based non-profit provided housekeeping, painting, landscaping and maintenance services to scores of families in need

Denver, Colo., October 2014 – Family Homestead, a Denver-based non-profit providing emergency and transitional housing to homeless families with children, received support from 31 employees of RedPeak, who took part in a day of housekeeping, painting, landscaping and maintenance services.

“Our entire team takes a great deal of pride in donating our time and service to the community-at-large, so it wasn’t difficult to have so many of our team members step-up and help-out Family Homestead,” said Mark Windhager, Chief Operating Officer of RedPeak. “Part of our company’s commitment is to help others in need, and this day of service provided us with another opportunity to do so.”

Family Homestead began in 1978 as the first agency in Denver to develop a transitional housing program for families, the first to implement a continuum of housing and social services; and the first to utilize Section 8 housing for homeless families. Today, Family Homestead is still the only agency in Denver that exists to provide emergency and transitional housing in *individual living units*, along with supportive case management, *exclusively* to families with children.
